**DATES & TIMES:** Our Farm Markets are open from 5PM to 7PM on the 1st and 3rd Wednesdays of each month:

**SET-UP & TAKE-DOWN:** Market Vendors should arrive no later than 4:20PM for set up and be fully set up by 4:50PM. Vehicles will be asked to move by 4:30PM. Market Vendors should not start take-down until 7:00PM.



**WEATHER:** Our Farm Markets are held outdoors rain or shine. However, the markets will be cancelled in the event of dangerous weather conditions.

**SAFETY:** The safety and security of our Farm Market attendees is our top priority. Vendors are required to adhere to all Farm Market Policies and Procedures and submit their Participant Agreement prior to vending.

**COMMUNITY RESILIENCE:** The multi-use nature of the Loiederman School Farm has been thoughtfully designed to support food production, climate resiliency, and serve as an educational outdoor resource accessible to tens-of-thousands of individuals from local schools and the greater community. The site is both a School Farm and a Resilience Hub, which supports sustainable local living, while also preparing to provide services, such as food distribution, public charging stations and other resources., in the event of a climate disaster.



**COMMUNITY PROGRAMS:** The Loiederman School Farm serves students and families within a 2-mile radius, including the 20 public schools attended by 17,000 students. Farm programs include: (1) Liaisons, who help build partnerships, (2) Volunteerships, to help maintain the gardens, (3) Internships for high schoolers, (4) Farm Club for middle schoolers (5) Care Farming for young adults with disabilities, and (6) Farm Markets with local vendors, food assistance services, workshops, live music, and more!
